****IMPORTANT- “Meet the Teacher”– August 9th from 1:00pm-3:00pm.
Come to the Cafeteria for class assignment, car rider tags and more!**

During the Kindergarten Orientation process, your child will attend orientation only ONE of the first TWO days of school:

Friday, August 10th (with last name A-M) or Monday, August 13th (with last name N-Z)

All Kindergarten students attend on August 14th.

School Hours will be 9:00am to 3:30pm for the students.

Office Hours are 8:15am to 4:15pm daily

(late bell at 9:00am)

✓ All student drop off will be in the car rider area.

The car rider area is located at 305 N. Palmetto Street. There is a one-lane entrance and a one-lane exit which is the entrance of the school on N. Palmetto Street. (*see below for traffic pattern information*) If you anticipate picking up your child at any time this school year please be sure to have a car rider number. Car Rider tags for 2018-19 will be available in the cafeteria during “Meet the Teacher” on August 9th from 1pm-3pm. Application forms are online to “pre-fill” - bring with you to the cafeteria on Aug 9th and get your new tag. Numbers will be new this year. Replacement tags will be \$1.00 if lost.

Remain in your car-we will assist with loading and unloading

- ✓ **DISMISSAL:** all bus students, K through 6, will be dismissed from their classrooms at 3:30 P.M. You can help us by memorizing your child’s car rider number with him/her.
- ✓ **REMINDER-Any changes to the students method home MUST be called in prior to 1:30**
- ✓ Go to Flagler County School’s Website to www.flaglerschools.com for **BUS Schedule** and other information
- ✓ **Cafeteria Prices:** Breakfast is served from 8:40-8:55 a.m. **Breakfast is no charge to BES students**
Lunch – full price \$2.10; Reduced price remains at 40 cents.
Free/Reduced lunch forms are available in the front office
- ✓ **MEDICATION TO NURSE:** Remember that medication cannot be sent to school with children and must be brought in with the proper forms completed to the nurse's office. An Emergency Contact must be listed and available to transport your child from school to home.
- ✓ **PUT CHILD’S NAME IN JACKETS-** We have many unclaimed jackets at the end of the year

BUNNELL ELEMENTARY DRESS CODE

Students are required to wear a school uniform at all times while attending school or any school-sponsored activity **during** the school day.

Pants/Bottom Attire

1. Must be khaki (tan), grey, white, navy blue, or black slacks, shorts, skirts, skorts or jumpers, or plain blue or black denim jeans, shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers. A small trademark logo is acceptable.
2. Bottom attire must be plain without any holes, tears, or unfinished hems, and must be worn securely at the waist.
3. If bottom attire has visible belt loops, a belt must be used. Students in grades K-3 are exempt from this.

Shirts

1. Shirts must be standard short or long sleeve polo style, oxford style, or button-up dress shirt with a collar. A small trademark logo is acceptable.
2. K-8 schools may use the district colors of white, black or grey and choose up to two additional standard school colors. (BES school colors are green and blue. Any shade) Shirts must be solid color and fabric. No lace or sheer materials, including "cut outs".
(On **designated** school Spirit Days or special events, students may wear their school logo t-shirt.)

Shoes:

Footwear that is a safety hazard will not be allowed (ex. Footwear with wheels, heels or slippers.) K-6 grade students must wear enclosed shoes or athletic shoes

Clothing and styles considered hazardous to health and/or safety are not allowed.
